

METHUEN CROSS CONNECTION

PERMIT INSTRUCTIONS

To be issued approval permit, you must submit a completed device design data sheet and a schematic that will show the details of the installation. The device design data sheet and schematic must be sent to the cross connection control office and to the plumbing inspector for approval.

1. A completed device design data sheet
2. A schematic (8 ½ x 11 inch) showing incoming water lines, the separation of domestic and process water, the type and model number of the device to be used and all clearances involved in the installation.

If the plans meet all the requirements, you will receive a letter of approval from this office to install the devices within a 30 day period. You must call this office to arrange for an initial test of the device/s once the installation/s are complete, any other test conducted prior to this initial test will be invalid. The initial test of the device/s ensures proper installation and operation.

Unprotected cross connections are in direct violation of the Drinking Water Regulations of Massachusetts. General Laws, Chapter III, Section 160A prescribe a Fine of \$500.00 and/or a year in jail for each willful violation.
